Pathways to Employment Expo

The `Pathways to Employment' Employment Expo aims to equip migrants and refugees with a range of effective strategies to gain a foothold in the job market. The 2011 Employment Expo will build on the success of the 2010 Expo for Migrants and Refugees which attracted 20 organisations and 1200 participants. The 2011 Expo will present information to help support critical choices facing people entering the workforce for the first time:

- What kind of job should I try to get first?
- How can I know what will suit me?
- Is my English language good enough for study or work?
- How can I find an apprenticeship?
- How can taking a pre-apprenticeship course help?
- What have other people from migrant or refugee backgrounds done that has helped them find a job?

Representatives of employer groups, education and training organisations, and specialist agencies and community organisations will help provide answers to these question through information stalls in the main Expo room. Interpreters in community languages (including languages of recently arrived and emerging communities) will be available.

Two seminar streams will be run in rooms off the main exhibition hall.
