If the applicant decides to execute the 'Holofnama' in front of a concerned officer of Bangladesh High Commission in Canberra then he / she needs to bring it in person to the High Commission in Canberra or Consular Camp in Sydney. A money order / bank draft (bank cheque; not personal cheque) of A\$ 11.00 in favour of 'Bangladesh High Commission, Canberra' will be required for executing the Affidavit (Holofnama) in front of a concerned officer of the High Commission in Canberra or at Consular Camp in Sydney. No fee will be charged by the High Commission for attestation of other necessary documents (photograph and copy of Bangladesh passport etc.) brought by the applicant in person to the High Commission in Canberra or at Consular Camp in Sydney.
