

Rajit, full name Tanim Hayat Khan. Born in Dhaka, he is originally from Shivpur village of Brahmanbaria. Rajit is the youngest son of Mobarak Hossain Khan and Fauzia Yasmin (Khan). Rajit is now settled in Sydney, Australia. Rajit is the grandson of music maestro of the subcontinent Ustad Ayet Ali Khan and belongs to the world famous music family. His another grandfather is Music Maestro Ustad Allauddin Khan, elder brother of Ustad Ayet Ali Khan. When Rajit was a baby, his mother Fauzia Yasmin used to do vocal practice (Reaz) every day in the morning by lying down Rajit on her lap. Rajit grown up gradually by listening to that tune. Rajit started his vocal practice from her mother Fauzia Yasmin, a popular singer in 1960s. His father Mobarak Hossain Khan is a musicologist and a well reputed Shur Bahar player. On top of that Hindustani Classical Music is already in Rajit's blood.

Rajit started learning Sarod from his Internationally Reputed cousin Ustad Shahadat Hossain Khan, who himself is a Sarod player. Rajit started to become expert in Sarod soon. He is used to perform in Bangladesh Betar and Bangladesh Television during his stay in Bangladesh. Currently Rajit is the disciple of Dr Adrian McNeil. Dr Adrian McNeil is the Head of Contemporary Music Department of Macquarie University. Dr Adrian McNeil himself was the disciple of Pandit Ashok Roy, one of the disciples of Rajit's Uncle Ustad Ali Akbar Khan.

Rajit's eagerness for singing emerged by listening to his mother Fauzia Yasmin and other three Aunt Farida Yasmin, Nilufar Yasmin and Sabina Yasmin's magical tunes. He started doing vocal practice and soon started singing as a prosperous singer. Although these days Rajit sings, but he is mainly familiar as a Solo Sarod player. Rajit belongs to a musician of "Seniya Maihar Gharana", the Gharana created by his grandfather Ustad Allauddin Khan.

Rajit performs Sarod and sings in different places of Sydney and other cities.

Professionally Rajit is an accountant. Along with his profession, he is also working as an Accounting and Finance teacher in TAFE (Department of Education). Rajit completed his MBA from University of Technology Sydney (UTS) with major in Professional Accounting.
