## Help Shoeb - An Update

During the month of September Dr Abdul Haq made an appeal to the Bangladesh community for helping Mainul Islam Shoeb. At that time Shoeb was fighting for a quick recovery at the Westmead Hospital.

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of December, we visited Shoeb and his family at his rented premise in Lakemba. He lives there with his wife Rehana Akter Mukti and five-month old daughter Samiha. The family arrived on 9<sup>th</sup> October. Due to his medical condition he moves on wheelchair and unable to speak properly. Even though he is on a permanent visa, his wife and daughter are on Bridging visa. They have recently applied for their immigration – the outcome of which will be known in few months time.

Caring for Shoeb has been a challenge due to his medical condition and the prospect of living with a limited financial assistance. His wife has been a full-time carer for her husband and their infant daughter.

In addition to continuous care, nursing and attention to Shoeb, the family needs an immediate assistance on the following areas:

**Home Help** – help around the houses; with shopping and chores; and with cooking meals on a regular basis.

**Transport** - help getting from home to a specified destination like shopping facility, government agencies such as Centrelink, medical centre or the hospital.

**Living arrangement** – Currently on a shared accommodation with friend at a rented premise not designed for people on wheel-chair.

**Financial support** - So far an amount of AUD 3255 was raised and handed over to Shoeb. On-going financial support is needed till the family becomes eligible for financial assistance from the government agency.

We believe that our community will keep continue their support for Shoeb in a much stronger way on a longer term basis.
