Alinoor, DG(Addl Secretary), IMED in the chair. AbdusSattar, XEN(Procurement), Local Govt Engg. Dept. and Kazi Sayeda Momtaz, Sr. System Analyst, RHD have been elected as the convenor and coconvenor of the 15-member committee respectively. As stated in the meeting, the govt will soon float international through e-GP tenders including completion of preparation of necessary documents for this.

DDC's Consultancy Project



Development Design Consultants Ltd (DDC), a reputed multi-disciplinary Consulting Organization, which ranks atop amongst the private firms in Bangladesh. DDC is currently involved in a number of major consultancy

projects of which one of the running project is - Dhaka Mass Rapid Transit Development Project (MRT line-6). The Salient Project Features are - i) Length of Metro Rail : 20.10 km, ii) Infrastructure Type : Elevated, iii) Route Alignment : Uttara 3rd Phase -Pallabi to west side of Rokeva Sarani through Khamarbari - Farmgate- Hotel Sonargaon-TSC-Doel Chattar-Topkhana Road to Motijheel, iv) Number of Stations : 16 nos, v) Passenger carrying Capacity : Both ways 60,000 per hour, vi) Travel Time : 37 minutes(Uttara to Motijheel). DDC is working in this prestigious project as Joint Venture Partner with other foreign firms. The project is expected to be commissioned by June, 2023.

Padma Bridge Rail Connecting Project

With a view to implement Padma Bridge Rail Connecting Project Bangladesh signed the loan agreement of USD 2670 million with Exim Bank of China on 27th April, 2018 at the head office of the bank in Beging, the capital city of China. The agreement was signed by Md. Jahidul Huq, Addl Secretary, ERD, Bangladesh and Vice President of Exim Bank respectively. Worth mentioning that during the visit of Chinese President, Shi Gin Peong in Bangladesh,

the memorandum of understanding was signed for funding construction of 172 km rail connecting project through Padma Bridge from Dhaka to Jessore via Narail. The estimated cost of the project being Tk 39,258 crore and 13 lac only of which China will contribute Tk 21,360 crore and 69 lac and rest amount will be shared by Bangladesh respectively.

BWDB Holds Workshop

On January 09, 2019 a workshop on Long Term Monitoring Research & Analysis(LTMR&A) of Bangladesh coastal zone was organized jointly by Bangladesh Water Development Board(BWDB), Institute of Water Modelling(BWM) and DHI & Deltares. VThe purpose of the study of the 400 million dollar World Bank assisted Project is to provide design parameters considering Climate Changes for rehabilitation of the existing polders on



sustainable concept. Mr. Kabir Bin Anwar, Secretary, Ministry of Water Resources, remained present as the Chief Guest at the inaugural session while Prof. Emiratus & eminent Water Expert, Dr. Ainun Nishat, DG, BWDB and Addl. Secretary, Ministry of Water Resources, attended as the Special Guests. The address of welcome was delivered by Engr. Habibur Rahman. PD, CEIP and Chief Engineer, BWDB. The key note paper was presented by Jan Adriaan Roelvink, Dr. Irina Overeem, Dr. Steve Goodbred and the Technical Session became lively with valuable open discussion among the participants.
