Please help me Live!

I am Sima Mitra. My husband, our 8 years old daughter and I have come from Bangladesh to Australia on a Regional Migration visa on 29th March this year. Because of our visa



condition (regional migration category) we have to live in a regional country town. That is why we are now living in Albury, NSW. As per the condition of our visa, we are not eligible for any financial assistance from the Australian Government until we stay here on our own cost for two years. Unfortunately, my both kidneys are damaged and I have to undertake dialysis twice per week. To continue my treatments, I have to pay \$630 per dialysis and also nearly \$200 per week as pathology bills and doctor's fee. None of us could find a job in this country town, hence, my family has no earning in this country. All our savings we brought from Bangladesh has run out totally. Now I have no food, no money to pay my house rent (\$180 per week), food cost (minimum \$50 per week), utility bills (\$300 per month) and treatment cost. I have no way of going back to Bangladesh because we both resigned from our previous jobs before we left for Australia in the hope of a good life here, plus we will not be able to pay my treatment cost there. In this circumstance, my life is at risk and in this way my little daughter's life is also at risk as she will be alone here without me. I wish to survive and live with my family. But without any financial assistance from anyone it is completely impossible for us to survive here. So, I urge your sympathetic consideration and seek financial help from you to save my life and also my daughter's life.
